

PRESIDENT: You may call in your vote to the Clerk and a record vote has been requested. The motion is the adoption of an amendment explained by Senator Warner to LB 722. You may call in your vote to the Clerk. All members of the Legislature, please return to the Legislative Chamber. The house is under call. Members within the Chamber, please look up to the board in front of the room and see that your presence light is on, your green light. Senator Scofield, please, and Senator Smith. Senator Higgins and Chronister. Senator Rupp. Senator Lowell Johnson, please, and Rod Johnson. Eight members are excused at the present time. A roll call has been requested. Oh, now a roll call has been requested. Senators Higgins and Marsh need to record your presence. We're not voting now. This is a recording of presence for a call of the house. Senator Haberman, please. Senator Chambers and Rod Johnson. Senator Rupp. Senator Schmit. Senator Haberman, the house is under call. Please return to the Chamber and record your presence. A roll call vote has been requested, members. We are waiting the arrival of Senator Haberman. If the Sergeant would please check on the whereabouts of Senator Haberman. Here we are. All members who are not excused are present now under the call of the house and a roll call has been requested. May we have quiet in the Chamber, please, (gavel) so the Clerk may hear your vote.
