We are voting on the motion to cease debate on this particular amendment related to LB 83. Please record your vote. The motion is to cease debate. The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. Senator Warner, do you wish to close? Order in the Chamber, please, so we may hear the speaker. (Gavel.) Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move that the amendment be adopted. It is...only has the impact to in the event LB 83 is advanced and put on General File or passed, why the appropriation bill would accommodate that decision. The amendment itself does not determine the fate of LB 83. So I'd move its adoption.

PRESIDENT: The motion is the adoption of the amendment just under discussion. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 4 nays on adoption of the committee amendment that deals with Section 12 of that portion, Mr. President.
