SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Mr. President, but before I close I don't think there is 25 people on the floor. I would ask for a call of the house.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. A call of the house has been requested. The question is, shall the house come under call. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. The motion is for the house to come under call. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 8 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The house is under call. All members of the Legislature, please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Members in the Chamber, please turn on your green lights indicating your presence. Please record your presence, those of you who are in the Chamber. Please turn on your green light. Senators Wesely, Lamb and Schmit, please record your presence. Senator Higgins also. The house is under call. All members return to the Legislature and record your presence. Five members are excused at the present time.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Mr. President, I think we can resume.

PRESIDENT: You may begin to close.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Mr. President. For those of you that were not on the floor for the debate, in my opening remarks I said and asked that LB 556 be advanced to Select File. At that point in time we should have the Appropriations Committee's requests in front of us. We
