

We are voting on the Judiciary Committee amendments to LB 663. Please record your vote. Twenty-five votes required to adopt committee amendments. Please record your vote. The committee amendments to the bill are in the process of being voted on. Have you all voted on the adoption of the committee amendments? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of committee amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The committee amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Landis would move to amend the bill and Senator Landis's amendment is on page 2320 of the Journal.

SENATOR LANDIS: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, I promised Senator Labedz I wouldn't take more than five minutes. The amendment appears in the Journal, take a look at it. It simply advises that at the time that these kinds of informational requirements are being carried out that one of the pieces of information be that a person be advised of agencies and services available for prevention of future unintended pregnancies. If there are dangers with respect to multiple abortions or multiple childbirths, perhaps women ought to be advised about how they can forestall those dangers from coming about and that's why that amendment is in there. I'd offer it for the adoption of the body.

PRESIDENT: The motion is the adoption of the Landis amendment to the bill. Senator Labedz. Anyone wish to speak on the Landis amendment? Anything further, Senator Landis? The motion is to adopt the Landis amendment to the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the adoption of Senator Landis's amendment to the bill. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Landis's amendment to the bill.

PRESIDENT: The Landis amendment is adopted and we have 22 minutes left on debate time.
