SENATOR HOAGLAND: Senator Chambers, the figure is not 19. I recognize that that may be what the fiscal note indicates, but we have appropriated \$33,000 from general funds and \$78,000 from federal funds to the Attorney General's Office.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: You have appropriated how much to the Attorney General's Office? This is...now what I am getting at, the total that is being appropriated is 200 and something thousand dollars. Is that correct?

SENATOR HOAGLAND: No, your...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That is the total.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: No, your question was for the automated computer system.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, so that will be \$200,000.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: That will be 220 state funds, 650 federal funds.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And how much for the Attorney General's Office?

SENATOR HOAGLAND: 78 thousand...I'm sorry, \$33,000 general funds, \$78,000 federal funds.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And what other items are in there that appropriations will be necessary for? And I am just interested in the state funding.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Basically, for this coming fiscal year we are appropriating \$7,500 for the study provided for in Section 77 of the committee amendments.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So there are only three items that we have to deal with, the automated system which is \$220,000. The Attorney General's Office gets \$33,000. Then there is \$7,500 for the study.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Senator Chambers, I believe that is correct.
