

some bureaucrats who can be very heavy-handed on selected cases just like they select cases now to enforce child support laws on. How are they able to catch those at positions one, three, five and seven but they can't get two, four and six who are similarly situated in the same area? If they can enforce it on some, they can enforce it on others. This bill is not needed this session. It was hurriedly brought to the Legislature. The committee members who signed it signed on to it. I don't think there is a thorough understanding of everything that the bill will do and there is no way the members of the Legislature who have not looked at this bill can be given this much material as serious as the bill is and I am not just talking about the length. There are some significant provisions in it and the implications of them ought to be completely understood. This bill should be bracketed until next year. These people who are pushing and want a study should not be studying this bill which will not take effect until September 1st of next year. They should be studying the current system and then come back with a justification for this bill. But if all they are going to do is put more legislation on the books and say, maybe it will cause more enforcement, maybe it won't, then they haven't told us a justification for this bill. So in connection with the amendment I am offering, I want to ask Senator Hoagland to give him an opportunity while I am speaking to tell me what in addition to this record-keeping system, what in addition to child support enforcement will this record-keeping system be available for.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Well, Senator Chambers, I have my light on, of course, to oppose your amendment and would like to address the subject in detail as to why we have to leave Section 76 in the bill. Specifically, in response to your question...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Uh huh.
