

Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The committee amendments are adopted. Now we are back on the bill. Senator Hoagland. Oh, you have a motion. Okay. You don't have a motion. We are back on the bill then. Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: I move to advance the bill as amended.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any discussion? Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Labeledz, don't you misunderstand what I am doing. It is late and people are tired, I'm not. But when we get to Select File I want you all to remember that you wanted to delay everything until Select File. We may not even get to the bill, but I'm going to give you what you asked for because Senator Labeledz asked, and she had stayed here long and suffered to try to help me with some of the things I legitimately tried to get done to the bill. But when it comes to Select then don't whine and say it's taking too much time. You chose to delay the debate until then.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, frequently at this time of the session we do things in this manner that we don't ordinarily do. I want to say right now I do not like the bill, I didn't like the amendments, but I will also vote to advance the bill to Select File because I know it is not fair to hold up this bill at this time because it is very important. To hold it up might mean that it might not have a chance to be debated again. I'm sure that Senators Higgins and Hoagland would do the same for anyone else. So I will also vote to advance the bill. But I would certainly ask all of you to take a good look and to check with those people who want the bill because it is not an easy bill for me to vote for.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hoagland, would you like to close?
