

now gone back and had that confirmed. Number two, the Governor says that if this body is determined to pass the DeCamp amendment, then in all honesty we should simply gut the bill and put in a provision that makes bank tax returns nonconfidential and let the public decide whether or not the banking community in the State of Nebraska pays its fair share. That is probably an idle threat. But I am just simply saying that sometimes, sometimes the Legislature has to write legislation and not the lobby, sometimes. For right this moment this piece of legislation has been written by the lobby. We may pass it, but it is going to go down to defeat, according to the Governor. It will be vetoed. So I think that the Legislature should write the legislation. We've done that with LB 717. We've got an opinion now which says it is constitutional. It will generate about \$3 million of additional money. I say let's remove the DeCamp amendment and then advance 717 and pass it and go about our regular business.

SENATOR LUNDY: Roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: The question before you now is, shall the house come under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The house is under call.
