

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is, shall the rules be suspended? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. It takes 30 votes. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 20 nays to suspend that rule, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion fails.
