Do you know how much a lying social worker in Hall County starts at per month? \$1,063 per month. That's what the liar gets. Now here is the maximum that a woman eligible for ADC with two children can get if she gets the maximum of everything, \$621, \$350 of which is in cash and this liar called Senator Nelson and said \$350 in cash is more than \$1,063. I don't know how they figure in Hall County, but those are the kind of lies that are told to senators, senators swallow it, they regurgitate it on the floor and it is used as a basis to cast a bad vote and we're supposed to let these things go by and not deal with them. These are serious matters. That brings me back to what I am offering in my amendment to Senator Beutler's amendment.
