

SPEAKER NICHOL: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But what I hope you will do is pierce through everything that I've talked about, which may be apparently irrelevant, and look at what it is I'm offering with this amendment. The amendment simply says that no program, under Agency 26, will be exempt from the cut. I hope you will adopt it, then we'll move on from there. I'd like a call of the house.

CLERK: 7 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

We're looking for Senator Pirsch, Senator Schmit. Senator Chambers, I believe we are all here. Senator Chambers. Did you ask for a roll call vote, or not? (Gavel.) Ladies and gentlemen, we are voting on the adoption of the Chambers motion. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Roll call vote has been called for. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2515 of the Legislative Journal.) 24 ayes, 16 nays, Mr. President, on the motion.
