SPEAKER NICHOL: Question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do. The question is, shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. This is to cease debate. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 2 nays to cease debate, Mr. President, on the motion to reconsider.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Debate has ceased. Senator Vard Johnson, would you like to close on your motion please.
