SENATOR SMITH: Yes, thank you, Mr. President. I would just like to make a point here. Senator Nichol, I would like to address you particularly and Senator Wesely. I want you to know that not only do I have my little toothbrush with me, not just today but everyday so I am ready, too. Thank you.
