But those in the underwater boats could see everything that was happening on the surface. So, if the one on the surface was dealing only with surface craft, the surface craft may merely be a decoy, then the underwater boat does its damage. So there may be underwater boats at work here. There may be termites in the woodwork here. Maybe what appeared to be such a solid proposal unassailable is being assailed right now. But in the meantime, you are going to cast a vote to cut the school lunch program. I don't think that is a conscionable thing to do. But to show that I am getting in the spirit of what you all have shown me...
