

recently done some of the same kind of things to I guess it is a matter of venting some steam that we have because of the decisions we have had to make and I want to take just a moment and tell you what the case is. You understand it, I know, but I want to say it again. We had three choices, raise taxes, or cut budgets, the third choice being two ways of cutting the budget; 2 percent across the board or an Appropriations Committee approach towards more specific programs. Now if you want to talk about the Appropriations Committee's budget process, the programs that they are talking about cutting when you match them up against the other programs, human needs all across the board, then we are prepared to stand here and defend the choice if we have to. If you start talking about it's a bad program to cut because it is a worthy program, you are not going to get any arguments. We never said we were going to cut unworthy programs and leave all the worthy ones in there. We did the original budget process in the last five months. We came out with our original figure to you about a month ago. We said, you want a recommendation, here it is. That recommendation is going to call for a tax increase. You said you don't want a tax increase, we will take 2 percent across the board. You all said it is a bad idea. We said we can try to do it on a more specific basis, more specific basis. We did it. That is what we are talking about now. If you have got an argument with it, argue it when it gets time to pass the whole amendment knowing that if the amendment doesn't pass, if we don't get some other kind of cut that you are going to raise taxes or you are going to look at another kind of across the board budget, don't argue about the process. Now back to this particular amendment, the ADC unborn program, Senator Warner has already told you LB 31 is the bill that is going to do everything. It is going to be coming up. The funding proposition here is that if LB 31 passes, the funds are deleted. If it doesn't pass, the funds are left in. This is not the place to argue it. We are going to, I can see it. But this is not the place. This is just the funding. The argument will be on the bill which changes statute, which is what has to be done in order to have this program implemented. What do you have right now? Senator Miller said you have nothing right now. We are talking about a three month period, second trimester; months, three, four, five...excuse me, months, three, four, five or four, five, six, whichever one you want to talk about. The second trimester, there is no state funded program if we eliminate this for women's housing and
