

would you please give me your attention. If you adopt this, you are going to be here until eleven o'clock tonight on these five issues because it is divisible and beings as they are divisible, we are going to take up again each one of these and if there is just only two amendments put on, it is going to take six hours because you say 15 minutes to open and close, two or three people get 10 minutes apiece and we are going to go over and over and over. Senator Chambers has done it. He will do it again. If he hasn't done it, he sure taught this cowboy how to do it. So if you adopt it, just plan on being here till eleven o'clock, now it is going to be twelve, because we have hashed all of this out once and I will tell you we are going to hash them out again because it is divisible. We can take them one by one. So I want you to think about that and think what you are doing. You are putting yourself on a box on time. And as Senator Chambers says, I will stay here just as long as the rest of you. Thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Thank you, Mr. President. My error, I ask to have my name taken off the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Very well, Senator Marsh. Senator Marsh's name is withdrawn from the amendment. Senator Warner. Senator Warner. After Senator Warner the Chair will recognize Senator Lamb, Hartnett, Labedz, Hannibal and Beutler.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I am going to oppose the substitute. During the last two days, really, beginning one-thirty yesterday afternoon I had no other thing in mind nor do I believe the majority of the Appropriations Committee and was to offer an alternative that came up to \$15 million which when we first started you could accept or reject, whichever way you wanted to go and that would still be my position. If this is rejected, you have a motion following for the suspension of the rule to take it up yes or no, and after that if you do not want to accept what the committee proposed, as it has now been amended, and I remind you again we were at \$16 million, not 15, assuming that there would be some adjustments made by the floor which is proper and there have been, we are still within the dollar amount that was proposed last Thursday when we adjourned or recessed. And I would hope you do it. Senator Haberman has mentioned
