

PRESIDENT: The motion is the adoption of the Beutler amendment under discussion. All those in favor...Beutler motion to substitute. Thank you. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you voted? Ten seconds to vote. There is one member excused at the present time. Time. Senator Beutler, what is your wish?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. President, I guess I would ask...I guess I would ask for...I guess I would ask for one more vote. I guess I would ask for someone to change their mind. I guess I would ask for a call of the house and a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: The question now is, shall the house come under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. The Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

PRESIDENT: The motion prevails and the house is under call. All members now turn on your presence light, please. Look up to the front. Senator Warner, record your presence. Thank you. Senator Pappas, Senator Chronister, Senator Miller. 48 members, 1 member excused. We are all present under a call of the house and a roll call vote has been requested. Will we please maintain silence in the Chamber so that the Clerk can hear your vote. Vote aye or nay. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 2542-43 of the Legislative Journal.) 24 ayes, 24 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. I know. Now, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Beutler, your motion is still before us.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I withdraw the motion.

PRESIDENT: The motion is withdrawn.

CLERK: The motion I have is by Senator DeCamp. Oh, excuse me, I have a priority motion, Mr. President. Senator Hall would move to reconsider the vote on Agency 13, Department of Education Program 294, elimination of Displaced Homemakers Program.
