So what I want to do is help fill up the time between now and when whatever is going to happen is going to happen and that's going to be my contribution. Don't leave, Senator Pirsch. I just noticed that I have a more attentive appearing audience here than I have had all day and I'm really talking about nothing. I was just shown a magazine whose title is Power Broker and I'm going to tell you what I'll do. No, I'm not going to read it to you, Senator Marsh. I'm going to not use all of the time that I have. I'm going to give that back and simply ask that you vote aye on this motion and on this particular one I'm not going to ask for a call of the house, I'm not going to ask for a roll call vote. I'll abide by what the machine says the first time around and whenever the Chair wants to call the vote, it's fine with me.

PRESIDENT: Then we will proceed to a machine vote on the Chambers motion to bracket LB 722 until June 10. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 3 ayes, 21 ayes on the motion to bracket, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion failed. Now, Mr. Clerk, what do you have?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to bracket until June 2.

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, this would simply put consideration of the bill off for two days and this is really the motion that I had in
