PRESIDENT: The motion fails. What do we have on the matter now, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion by Senator DeCamp to suspend Rule 6, Section 5, Rule 7, Section 3 and vote without further debate or amendment on the Beutler-Vickers amendment to LB 722.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DECAMP: It does just what it says. It's just a vote on the amendment now.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion? Senator Labedz. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. President, members, I'll just briefly say that I will oppose this motion. I did the vote for it to be adopted to the Beutler amendment in hopes that we would deal with the specific items identified. We did not. We still have intact a number of very detrimental elements to this amendment. I would ask all of you to weigh the good and the evil and I think after you look at it I hope you will find that on balance you cannot support this amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Abboud.

SENATOR ABOUD: I have a question for Senator Warner, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner is available.

SENATOR ABOUD: Senator Warner, as a result of the package that we adopted from the Appropriations Committee will we end up with a tax increase this year?

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Abboud, that issue rests on the accuracy of the projections. If the receipts are probably 99 percent accurate, why the answer to your question could be yes, that they will not be, but I cannot tell you the accuracy because only time will tell that of the projections.
