CLERK: 31 ayes, 9 nays on the motion to suspend the rules, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: They are suspended. Any further discussion? There is no discussion. The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor say aye...machine vote has been called for. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted that care to? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 11 nays on the motion to advance LB 722.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced. If you would just bear with us a little bit longer, there are four bills on Select File, appropriation bills, that are clean and have no amendments on them. They are 725, 728, 420 and 718. If we could advance those, this would help our E & R staff. Oh, you have an amendment on 725? Well, let's...Senator Warner, are you able to handle that at this time.

SENATOR WARNER: It's just to add the E clause, Mr. President. This is one that transfers the wards of the court from the Department of Education to Social Services. It needs to take effect July 1. That is it. I'd move adoption of the E clause. All the others are clean.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion on the E clause? Senator Higgins, did you wish to talk about the E clause? Your light is on.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Pardon me?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Your light is on. Did you wish to speak on the E clause?

SENATOR HIGGINS: No, I wanted to move to adjourn.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Oh, well, why don't you hold up a minute.
