The issue of Nebraska and its athletic programs and its University policies do come up. I have the opportunity to speak from a national platform, the others don't. So I will do, in every way at my disposal, what I think needs to be done. This discrimination can at least, can at least be spoken against by the Legislature in the mildest manner we have of speaking, and that is by passage of a resolution.
