CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay on adoption of Senator Warner's second amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The second Warner amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move the bill be advanced.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, any further discussion on the bill? Okay. The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote, opposed nay. Say aye, excuse me. Say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. LB 723.

CLERK: Mr. President, on 723 I do have E & R amendments, Senator Hall.
