SPEAKER NICHOL: While we're waiting for Senator Higgins, I would like to say to you that in a little bit I'm going to give you a list of the bills on the back of your agenda today that are on Select File that do not have amendments on them. You might get out a paper and pencil and I'll give those to you after this vote. But there are about 10...there are 11 bills on the back of your agenda that do not have amendments on them. Right after lunch we will run those bills so that we can get them out of the road. But we will continue on Select File appropriations bills today until we are through with them.
