SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move the bill be advanced.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Is there further discussion? I have no lights on, but it is debatable if you care to do so. The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance 723, Mr. President.
