CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Goodrich's amendment to the bill.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move that LB 564 be advanced from Select File to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB 564 from Select File. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced.
