PRESIDENT: Thank you, Senator Higgins. Senator Harris, do you wish to speak on the Hoagland-Hall amendments? Senator Harris? Senator Sieck.

SENATOR SIECK: Mr. President, members of the body, I cannot support the Hoagland amendment, but I will support the Hall amendment because it should get it off our back, and if they want to deal with it in the special session, so be it. I felt it should be dealt with today, but the body does not want to. I'm not afraid of the political ramifications. My people know how I stand and I have told them so, so there is no ifs and ands about it. I've had many calls that said, what's the idea? What's the idea? You just take it to put it in one pocket and put it in the other and that just don't make sense to me. That really don't make sense. And you must remember that there is a lot of renters out there that are helping their landowners. That don't make sense. I just...I can't buy that, but you said, no, so we have to do the next best thing because I do not want to implement it at the present time and force the business and farmers to have to pick up the load and that's what will happen. And their property tax will increase quite a bit. Now I'm not sure whether Senator Hall's amendment will do this, whether it will delay it, whether it is legal, but I'm willing to take that chance. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Senator Abboud, do you wish...very well. Senator Hall, we're on the Hoagland amendment to the Hall amendment.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, members, I would urge the body to reject the Hoagland amendment. I think we need to deal with it in the least amount of time as possible. I think we need to deal with it as soon as we can. To delay it to 1987 I think would be a mistake. I would urge the body to reject the Hoagland amendment and urge the body to support the Hall amendment which would have us deal with it in 1986. Thank you.
