But as it is now I have heard no good reasons, none at all. Senator Hoagland talked about truth and justice and fairness and all these things. All of those things were said...

SENATOR HABERMAN: ...and we understood all of those things.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Thank you. So I say to those who are considering changing their votes, just be sure in your hearts that you are not doing it because somebody hammered you or twisted you or...just do what you think you have to do but be sure in your heart and your conscience and your mind that you have a good reason for changing. Thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Vickers and then Senator Hefner and Chambers and Goodrich.

SENATOR VICKERS: Mr. President and members, I am rather disappointed that Senator Haberman didn't ask me since I was part of that meeting last night too. But for Senator Haberman's sake and for others that might wonder, I agreed last night to withdraw any amendments that I might have on the bill and not offer any more and I am keeping that agreement. I don't remember agreeing with anybody that I am not going to vote the way I want to vote on other amendments that might come up. I am not going to repeat a lot of the things that were said last night but I do want to repeat one thing and that is that I still think it is very important, I think it is very important that this body occasionally look at the process and I think that when you eliminate things like we are eliminating with 722, that it is...according to our process that we normally follow, we would give them the opportunity to have a public hearing, we would have full debate, three different stages of debate, do it the way it is supposed to be done.
