The motion is to adjourn and you may call in your vote to the Clerk on the motion to adjourn, aye or nay.

CLERK: Senator Barrett voting yes. Senator Goll voting yes. Senator Morehead changing from no to yes. Senator Warner voting yes. Senator Rupp...

PRESIDENT: Roll call vote has been requested. The motion is to adjourn. Members are to be in your seats. The Clerk will call the roll. Maintain silence. Aye or nay.

CLERK: (Read the roll call vote as found on page 2609 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: Do you have anything to record first, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: (Continued reading the roll call vote.) I am going to verify the vote, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Clerk wants to verify the vote. Please maintain silence.

CLERK: (Read verification of the vote.) 23 ayes, 19 nays to adjourn, Mr. President.
