and I both know just as things are happening right this minute, weeks ago we voted on 190, today all of a sudden it comes up when we have two days of legislation left and you are telling me then that in the next 75 days Congress will not change its mind when this Legislature is being asked to in the last two days of the session. That is all I wanted to know. I want to get it straight for the record. Thank you, Senator Johnson.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Johnson, you may close.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker, Senator Lynch has said in closing that I should simply point out that we really don't care whether or not Congress decides to repeal the cigarette tax. We are simply covering our flanks in the event Congress does not undo its repealer of the cigarette tax. That is all this does. I ask your support.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the amendment offered by Johnson and Wesely. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on the Johnson-Wesely amendment to 653A. Please record your vote. If you wish to vote on the Johnson-Wesely amendment please do so. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 4 nays on adoption of Senator Johnson and Wesely's amendment.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Would you move to advance, Senator Johnson.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Move to advance.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to advance 653A. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried, the bill is advanced. Now we move to number 460.

CLERK: Give me a moment, Governor.

PRESIDENT: Very well.

CLERK: Mr. President, on LB 460 I have E & R amendments.
