LB 157, 204A

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp. Oh, Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: I would move LB 157 be advanced from Select File to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB 157 from Select File. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Machine vote.

PRESIDENT: A machine vote has been requested. A machine vote is requested. All those in favor of advancing LB 157 from Select File vote aye, opposed vote nay. Call of the house is raised. The motion is to advance LB 157 from Select File to Enrollment and Review for Engrossment. Please record your vote if you wish to vote. Twenty seconds for recording of your vote. Motion is...have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 16 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance 157.

PRESIDENT: LB 157 is advanced. Next I think we have a request to go back to LB 204A.

CLERK: Mr. President, 204A was earlier considered. I have a motion to indefinitely postpone the bill by Senators Miller and Vickers.

PRESIDENT: Senators...Vickers, do you want to figure out the time between the two of you here? Senator Miller.

SENATOR MILLER: I'm just moving to indefinitely postpone this. It is not needed, there is no appropriation needed and as I understand the regulations we just can't leave it sit there, we have to move it.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to indefinitely postpone LB 204A. Is there further discussion? If not, the motion is to indefinitely postpone the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record. We need 25 votes because we are on Select File. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 3 nays, on the motion to indefinitely
