LB 204A, 518, 632, 632A

postpone LB 204A, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is indefinitely postponed. We move to LB 632.

CLERK: Mr. President on 632 E & R amendments have been adopted. It was considered on May 8th. I have nothing pending on the bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Vard Johnson, do you want to move it?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Vard Johnson would move to bracket LB 632 until January 1, 1986.

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, 632 and 632A call for an increase in ADC payments. It appears that this body has done a remarkable in simply holding firm on current level the benefit for ADC recipients. I think Senator Labeledz has done an excellent job in making certain that we maintain the ADC benefits to pregnant women and to unborn children. We have maintained benefits for unemployed parents and their children. We have maintained benefits in the ADC... or in the Ribicoff program. My personal belief, and I have discussed this with Senator Chambers, I didn't have a chance to talk to Senator Goodrich about it, is that this bill simply should be laid over until next year. So for that reason I would offer a motion to bracket 632 until the beginning of the next legislative session.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on the motion to bracket? If not, you will vote on the motion to bracket. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. You are voting on the motion to bracket LB 632 until January 1986. Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to bracket LB 632, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries, the bill is bracketed. LB 632A. Very well we will push that along with it. LB 518. Any time you have matters to the record, Mr. Clerk, go ahead.
