SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I move that LB 247 be advanced from Select File to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion to advance LB 247 from Select file. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried, the bill is advanced. Now we go to LB 539.

CLERK: Mr. President, on 539, Senator Beutler, you had a motion to indefinitely postpone the bill at one time, Senator. That is the first item up.

PRESIDENT: LB 539. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, I think I will leave that motion on. As far as I can see there is no particular need for this bill at this point in time. Why don't I withdraw it temporarily, Mr. Clerk.

PRESIDENT: Pass over you mean?
