

some of the fluctuations aside from the economy and I am not putting those down, but aside from the economy that has created a problem. So if the reduction is primarily...and I think this is accurate this year, primarily on the income tax side, an adjustment in the rate may only be compensating for those changes that have occurred. But again the sole reason that I offer it is in light of what at least I perceive and I think all of you realize, because it has been stated many times, the obligations that you have deferred till next year, that we have deferred, new legislation enacted in previous sessions, not this one, which takes effect next year. You add all of those things together and you find ourselves in the same difficulty that we have now and then on top of that if those projections are not a 100 percent and they will not be, then even further pressure is put on to make further elimination of total programs. So I would urge you to at least adopt the amendment and advance the bill. If it turns out we do not need it, it can be voted down.
