CLERK: (Read the roll call vote as found on page 2635 of the Legislative Journal.) 22 ayes, 25 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. Where are we are now, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, the next motion I have is by...I have, Senator Lamb, your kill motion once again, Senator.

PRESIDENT: The call of the house is raised.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President, that hasn't been considered already.

PRESIDENT: Well, the bill stays where it is. Is there a motion? Senator Warner, is there any disposition you want to make of the bill that lies still on...Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion from Senator Chambers to reconsider the vote just taken.

PRESIDENT: Proceed to the next bill, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next bill is LB 31. I do have E & R amendments, Senator Hall.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hall. (Gavel.)

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move the E & R amendments be adopted.

PRESIDENT: The motion is that the Enrollment and Review amendments be adopted to LB 31. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next motion I have to the bill is a motion to indefinitely postpone LB 31. That is offered by Senator Labeledz. Withdraw, Senator? Mr. President, Senator Labeledz would move to amend the bill. (Read the Labeledz amendment as found on page 2636 of the Legislative Journal.)
