

indefinitely postponed, but in respect to what Senator Warner asked me to do, since it was an appropriations bill, he asked me to leave the bill on Select File. Now if anyone in the Legislature would like to introduce a bill next year to eliminate, Senator Nelson or anyone else can introduce another bill on General File or have a committee hearing and then advance it to General File if they can get it done and then you will have the same opportunity to eliminate it next year.

SENATOR NELSON: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Is there further...Senator Warner, do you wish to make a comment on the Labeledz motion?

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, Senator Labeledz has indicated exactly what I had indicated to her. I had no objection if you wanted to strike the amendment. I would prefer that the bill just sat there and for the obvious reason, that at the end of next session there may be a need for that bill to be used and that almost happens every session and I am more comfortable if it is one of mine.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the Labeledz motion? If not, Senator Labeledz, go ahead and close.

SENATOR LABEDZ: I ask the members of the Legislature to support the amendment deleting the committee amendments and then I would also ask that the bill not be advanced and it just remain on Select File.

PRESIDENT: The motion is the adoption of the amendment to LB 31 offered by Senator Labeledz. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please vote. Please record your vote on the Labeledz motion. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay on adoption of Senator Labeledz's amendment to the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted and the bill stays where it is. Right? Senator Labeledz.
