PRESIDENT: LB 31 remains on Select File awaiting the second session of the Eighty-ninth Legislature. Now, Mr. Clerk, are we ready to go back to...Mr. Speaker, are you present on the floor? Mr. Speaker, could you direct us on the agenda from here? We finished LB 31 and...

SPEAKER NICHOL: Mr. President, yes, and members of the Legislature, I was mistaken in believing that 713 didn't want to be brought up. Members do want it to be brought up. It will be brought up now. There is a priority motion up. Of course, it would take precedence. But the question was asked whether or not we take 713 up, and, yes, we will take 713 up and 127 up.

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers has a motion on the desk that will take priority.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to reconsider on LB 539. Senator Chambers would move to reconsider the vote on the Warner amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, I talked to the Speaker about this. There have been some movement...there has been some movement on the floor which makes me feel this is the proper time to take up the motion. It is still fresh in everybody's mind. I think the debate is still clear in everybody's mind to the extent where we don't need an extended debate. We can move to a vote on the motion and I don't even have a lot to say other than that I am making the reconsideration motion because I am in favor of the Warner amendment and that is to add this increase of one percent to the income tax, attach it to the bill and move it so that if it is needed, it is in a position for us to make whatever use of it is necessary. That is the motion. I hope you will adopt it. But you have to have the reconsideration vote.

PRESIDENT: The motion of Senator Chambers is to reconsider the vote on the previous Warner motion and the matter is debatable. Senator Abboud, do you wish to speak? Okay, Senator Beutler. Senator Beutler. Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, I rise to oppose this reconsideration motion. We voted on
