CLERK: 14 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries and the house is under call. Members, now look up to the front and turn on your presence light, please. Turn on your green light. Members outside the Chamber, please return to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Warner, turn on your light, please. Senator Jerome Warner, please. Green light. Senator Schmit. Senator Hannibal. Rod Johnson. Senator Marsh. Senator Landis. Senator Labeledz. Senator Vickers. Senator Labeledz and Senator Landis. Vickers, Labeledz, Landis and Rod Johnson. Rod Johnson, Labeledz, Senator Rod Johnson is excused, very well. Senator Pirsch, Labeledz and Senator Baack. Senator Baack, please report to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Baack is now here. Turn on your presence light, Senator Baack. That makes 49 members present. And Senator Chambers has requested a roll call vote. The motion is the reconsideration of the previous Warner motion on LB 539. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. The Clerk will call the roll.
