You've got a dam over in Idaho. What does it take to get your vote? That's what we're doing. That's what the business of politics is all about. I make no secret of it. Okay now, Senator Wiley, you can denounce me for it.

SENATOR REMMERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I appreciate Senator DeCamp giving me this opportunity. I did have my light on and did want to speak. I'll make it real brief. Senator DeCamp handed out a letter last week that had three Attorney General's Opinions that the state cannot pay that amount. We've had two court decisions that says we cannot pay this amount. So if you're going to put the video slots and the Commonwealth situation into one bill and it passes, then it will be tried in court. The courts will throw it out. We will have the video slot bill, but Commonwealth will have empty pockets. Thank you.
