

Senator DeCamp's motion to reconsider.

PRESIDENT: We have voted to reconsider. Now Senator Pappas.

SENATOR PAPPAS: Mr. President, colleagues, very reluctantly because it seems Senator DeCamp just always picks on my bills and my amendments, this time I'll yield to my colleague and ask that the amendment be withdrawn.

PRESIDENT: Okay. Senator Chambers, did you want to speak?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, I've been so nice around here today and people seem to be developing such a mellow attitude toward me, which is so uncharacteristic for the end of the session, that I think I might have a few priority motions to put on Senator DeCamp's LB 127 because of the way the bill has been handled and what has happened today and the fact that I'm very offended over what happened to my amendment. However, John, I'm going to resist it and not do it. I'm still going to vote against striking the amendment, though.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion? Senator Pappas has asked for his motion to be withdrawn. All those in favor of the motion...Senator Pappas has withdrawn his amendment. Now we can vote on advancing the bill. Senator DeCamp. Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move that LB 127 be advanced from Select File to E & R for Grossment.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to advance LB 127 from Select File. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. We go to 663.

CLERK: Mr. President, on LB 663, I have no E & R amendments, I do have an amendment from Senator Labeledz, it is on page 2586.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Labeledz.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: May we have order in the Chamber please.
