CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on page 2659 of the Legislative Journal.) 41 ayes, 1 nay, 2 excused and not voting, 5 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 154 passes with the emergency clause attached. LB 717.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have motions on the desk. Senator Johnson would move to return 717 to Select File for a specific amendment. This is AM1617, Senator.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Is that Vard Johnson?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: What, AM1617?

CLERK: Yes.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: I thought it was AM1634.

CLERK: You have that here as well.
