PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 171 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 2683 of the Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 1 nay, 5 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 171 is declared passed with the emergency clause. Next we read the appropriations bill for LB 171.

CLERK: (Read LB 171A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 171A pass with the emergency clause attached? Have you all voted on LB 171A? Please record your vote. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 2684 of the Legislative Journal.) 41 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 171A is declared passed with the emergency clause. We'll skip over the 201 bills and the 208 bills, and go to LB 269 with the emergency clause.
