But I got voted down and they became the Mayor's Commission on the Status of Women.

We who did it 15 years ago, before government grants were heard of, put you in the position you are in today. If you fall apart now because the money isn't there, then you are going to lose your credibility of how sincere you are in trying to help these people. Thank you, Mr. Chairman.
