CLERK: Let's do...do you want to the Power Review Board...oh, I'm sorry. Do you just want to vote on the separately or all together? It is up to you.

SENATOR SCHMIT: All together.

CLERK: Okay. Senator Schmit has reports on 2323, 2194, 2463, and 2514, Mr. President, regarding appointments to the Power Review Board, Natural Resources Commission and the Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing Board.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Chairman Schmit of the Public Works Committee.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, the committee reports are listed in your Journal. The committee met and all of the gentlemen appeared before the committee. They were all voted to be approved by the committee. I move for their approval by this body.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion? If not, the motion is to endorse and approve the gubernatorial appointments offered by the Chairman of the Public Works Committee. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote on the confirmation of nominees to the Power Review Board. Have you recorded your vote? Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays on approval of the confirmation reports as submitted by the Public Works Committee, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The confirmation reports are confirmed. The Chair has the privilege of announcing on behalf of Senator Baack that he has a guest under the north balcony, Mr. Allen Dillman of Morrill, Nebraska. Welcome to the Legislature, Mr. Dillman. There is a priority motion on the desk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp would move to adjourn until nine o'clock tomorrow morning.
