PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 723 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please cast your vote on the final passage of LB 723. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: (Record vote read.) 45 yes, 1 nay, 1 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President. (Vote appears on page 2716 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: LB 723 is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. Next the Clerk will read LB 724 with the emergency clause.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion on the desk. Senator Haberman would move to return 724 to Select File for a specific amendment.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Haberman. Senator Haberman's motion, you are up. Strictly according to the rules, members are to be in their seats during Final Reading.
