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which of course is the power of the executive branch primarily to call, in a special session you lose all your power and he has your power. That is what you are doing. I repeat, I am willing to come up with some rules that expedite the process and I have an amendment up there to do that but it does it without destroying the committee, without destroying every individual legislator and it does it in a fairly reasonable and efficient fashion so that you can do what you want in a special session, and until, until I get into that office over there, I am opposed to any sort of system such as Senator Beutler and the committee are proposing here, and that does not seem to be something that is real imminent so I will probably be opposing this attempt to take the power from the Legislature or destroy the Legislature. I would ask you to wait until I offer my amendment and consider if you want to do those things that simply expedite the process and make it more functional in a short session. And Senator Higgins raised an important point and, of course, the Governor can't answer...

PRESIDENT: One minute.

SENATOR DECAMP: ...as to everything he is going to have in any special session, but under these rules, everything he lost or couldn't get through in any session, he simply makes special order in the special session and then those matters bypass committee, only those matters get before the Legislature on the floor. It is really a one-man show, and under those circumstances, we might as well have the Governor, or whoever is the Governor, appoint 49 proxies to fill our seats because all power we were elected to handle will have been destroyed. I urge you to wait until you get to my amendment, and if you want to make changes consider those things which expedite the process. I am supporting the technical amendment that Senator Beutler is on right now. I am going to vote for that but I am doing that only because it is a technical amendment. I want it not to in any way indicate I am supporting those rules as such.

PRESIDENT: May the Chair have your attention please. (Gavel.) Let's have order in the Chamber please. The Chair would like to recognize the Speaker for a moment.
