with us and I suggested four o'clock and he thought that would be great. So if we are still on this, why I suggest we break into it and finish it afterward, or if we threw a break in there and then finish the rest of the business after the Governor speaks or so, so that you can somewhat plan about four o'clock for the Governor. Thank you, Mr. Chairman.

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, now, Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, at this point I don't think we ought to do that. We all have prerogatives. There was a bill that all of us had an interest in, the seat belt bill, and the Governor thought he was going to sign it, then he thought he was going to veto it, and there were several vacillations and it is within his prerogative to do that. So Senator Nichol said he could come at four and maybe we say he can't come at four, then maybe we would decide later that he can, but in the meantime, I don't think we ought to lock ourselves into that because I may be speaking at three fifty-nine and maybe I will just be recalcitrant and not sit down, so what would happen in that case, or do you think I would be a gentleman and bow to your wishes? We will just have to wait and see, won't we?

PRESIDENT: Senator Morehead is next. Do you wish to speak? And, Senator Labedz, do you wish to speak on the motion? Senator Vickers is next and then Senator Hoagland and Beutler.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Mr. President. I was going to ask Senator DeCamp a question but maybe I will first explain how I think what happens, the Governor introduces bills. We are allowed to introduce bills. They are referenced, they go to a committee, and if the committee thinks it is a bad bill, all they do is recommend that the bill be indefinitely postponed, but it still comes to the entire body. In other words, if it is a good bill or bad bill, we are going to hear it anyway only with the recommendation of the committee. Am I right, John? Senator Beutler, do I understand that correct?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Labedz, I didn't hear exactly what you said. Would you repeat it?
