Senator Smith, Senator Higgins, Senator Haberman, Senator Carsten, Senator Hoagland, Senator Chambers. The house is under call. All members of the Legislature, please return to the Chamber for a call of the house. Senators Warner and Schmit, Senator Chambers and Senator Haberman. Haberman and Chambers, Schmit and...Senator Schmit. Senator Schmit, Haberman and Chambers, please return to the Chamber. Members may call in your vote to the Clerk if you wish. The motion is the adoption of the DeCamp amendment which is an amendment to the rules. Members may call in your vote to the Clerk. Senator Schmit, we're waiting on you to return to the Chamber, please.

CLERK: Senator Nelson changing from no to yes.

PRESIDENT: And, Senator Chambers. Members may...

CLERK: Senator Schmit voting yes. Senator Hannibal voting no. Senator Landis changing from no to yes.

PRESIDENT: Members may still vote on the rules change offered by Senator DeCamp. Have you all voted?

CLERK: Senator Lundy voting no.

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 13 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendment passes and I believe now we are in the position of getting ready to have the Governor come in.
