Senator Pirsch, do you have a motion? Call of the house is raised. Thank you. Senator Pirsch.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Mr. President, I move that a committee of five be appointed to advise the Governor that the Eighty-Ninth Legislature, First Session, of the Nebraska State Legislature is about to complete its work, and to return with any message that the Governor may have for the Legislature.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion to appoint a committee. The Chair will appoint that committee. We have to adopt the motion first to appoint the committee. Senator Morehead.

SENATOR MOREHEAD: Mr. President, we are so close to having this business finished that I really object to inviting the Governor in just at this moment. I think that we could complete our business without losing the train of thought. It would be very easily done, and I am sure that our great leader would not mind waiting just a few minutes, since several of us have waited on him just a few minutes on more than one occasion. PRESIDENT: Speaker Nichol.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Morehead and members of the Legislature, I don't mind being jacked around, but I want you to know one thing, you are going to be back here after the Governor is here. Now I know you are excited about not getting back here to do this amendment or the rest of whatever you want to do today. It is not a ploy on my part. Let's go ahead with the way we had planned it. We told the Governor around four o'clock. Okay? Let's go ahead with it the way it is planned.

PRESIDENT: Are we ready to vote on the motion to appoint the committee? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Motion is to appoint an escort committee to bring the Governor into the Legislative Chamber. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 1 nays to adopt the motion.

PRESIDENT: The motion is adopted. The Chair appoints the following committee: Senator Labedz, Senator Higgins, Senator Lundy, Senator Goodrich and Senator Beutler. Would
