For God sake, do you know any Legislature in the United States that is more subject to being talked about in the newspaper or having every aspect of your life viewed by the public? That is who is responsible for you ultimately besides, not Chris Beutler, or John DeCamp, or Ernie Chambers. And yet you are setting up a system where I can worry about whether Ernie had five drinks at \$5.20 a drink which might occur in New York or whether he had 10 at 2.50 which is perfectly okay, and then if he did or I think he did, I would file a complaint with the Rules Committee, Senator Morehead. Senator Morehead is then going to sit in judgment as to whether I should sit here in the Legislature. Now Senator Beutler says there are no criminal sanctions. The accountability law, most of that that they file actions on aren't under criminal sanctions, they are under other things but can they harass? Well, for the very statements I made on the floor of the Legislature for which bills were passed, I was charged over there. Spent 29,000 going through the courts to have them throw out every thing the Accountability Commission did. Harassment, you had better believe it, and you are setting up the same system. What amazes me is after our forefathers went to so much trouble to make sure you can function without intimidation at every point, a few would like to worry about every aspect of your life. Read those rules. Comparing us to the U.S House of Representatives. I don't know if that is a reasonable comparison. We are not the U.S. House of Representatives. This is a part-time job theoretically. But under these rules, every part of our life is supposed to be watched at every moment. Now is there anybody in here that there isn't something that some charge couldn't be filed? Has anybody ever stepped out on their wife or husband, huh? If I know about it I guess I can file a complaint that it might bring disrespect on the Legislature. Has anybody ever done this or that, postcards, or anything else? Why don't, it is election year, this is a campaign game and we all know it, why don't we consider this that those people running for office, be they Governor, Legislature, or whatever, those people running for office
