Mr. Sergeant, are you having any luck locating the members? If the offices of Senators Hefner, Goodrich, and Conway are listening, these members... Senator Goodrich is here. Senators Conway and Hefner, your presence is requested in the Chamber. The house is under Call. Okay, here they are. All members are here now who are not excused. Now then a roll call vote is being taken. Roll call vote is being taken on the adoption of a rule change proposed by Senator Morehead and you may call your vote in to the Clerk. You may call your vote in to the Clerk on this measure.

CLERK: Senator Hefner voting yes. Senator Conway voting no. Senator Goodrich voting no.

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 19 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the change. (See page 140 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: The rule change is adopted. The Chair has in mind to ask to entertain a motion to adjourn on or around three-thirty, according to the Speaker's plans. It depends on the matters under debate but it is up to you. I just wanted to let you know that is about the time we propose to begin winding up for the day. What do we have next on the board, Mr. Clerk? Senator Vickers, do you wish to speak on a point of personal privilege?

SENATOR VICKERS: Yes, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The call of the house is raised.

SENATOR VICKERS: Thank you, Mr. President. Mr. President, members, you are about to have distributed to your desks a copy of a study report done by the special committee that was created by this body last spring to study the issue of preschool special education. If you will recall, this is the committee that also received a grant from the National Conference of State Legislatures to study this particular issue and it has national implications in that Nebraska is one of a very few states that has been in the business of providing this service for the length of time that we have. This is a very well done study. I think you will find that it is a good source of information for anything, any question you might have regarding special education preschool and Senator Baack as the chairman of a task force
